Title 1 School-Wide Program

PURPOSE:

Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) Public Law 114-95 Section 116- Title I is the largest federal aid program for Elementary, Middle, Intermediate and High School. Through Title I, the Federal government gives money to school districts based on the number of low-income families.
